## **Representatives from the Quebec Public Inquiry Commission will visit the Atikamekw community of Manawan**

**Val-d'Or, August 10, 2017** – Representatives from the Public Inquiry Commission on relations between Indigenous Peoples and certain public services in Québec: listening, reconciliation and progress will be in the Atikamekw community of Manawan from August 15 to 17 to offer a public information session to members of the community and the Lanaudière Native Friendship Center. The presentation will take place on Tuesday, August 15, from 9:00 am at Otapi School, located at 470 Otapi Street in Manawan.

Invited by the Atikamekw Council of Manawan in collaboration with the Lanaudière Native Friendship Center, the Commission's team will be comprised of representatives from the Legal team, the Aboriginal relations team, the Support and wellness team and the Investigative team.

This community visit will allow the Public Inquiry's team to meet with members of the community, answer their questions and provide information about the mandate and operation of the Quebec Public Inquiry. The Investigation agents will be available during this time to meet with people in person who wish to share their stories with the Commission.
