Val-d'Or, August 15, 2017 – The Public Inquiry Commission on relations between Indigenous Peoples and certain public services in Québec: listening, reconciliation and progress is happy to announce new public information sessions that will be held in Roberval and Chibougamau on August 22nd and 23rd.

During these meetings, it will be possible to:

- Meet with the Commission's employees;
- Attend a public information session;
- Ask general questions on how the public hearings will take place in the coming months;
- Share information with employees present;
- Express general concerns about the Commission;
- Meet, in private, with one of our investigators to report situations that were experienced or witnessed in one of the six (6) public services targeted by this Commission.

In collaboration with the Centre d'Amitié Autochtone du Lac-St-Jean, the Quebec Inquiry will present a public information session on August 22, 2017 at 18:30. The session will be at the Centre d'amitié's office, located at 700, rue Otis.

Chibougamau

The day after, on August 23, 2017, the Quebec Inquiry will present a public information session in collaboration with the Chibougamau Eenu Friendship Centre. The session will start at 18:30 at the Chibougamau Town Hall.
