

The Québec Public Inquiry to present six new information sessions

Val-d'Or, October 5, 2017— Representatives from the Public Inquiry Commission on relations between Indigenous Peoples and certain public services in Québec: listening, reconciliation and progress will be in the Algonquin community of Rapid Lake, and in La Tuque and Trois-Rivières, during the week of October 8, to offer public information sessions. Also, during the same week, the Commission will present to three public organizations, namely the Abitibi-Témiscamingue Integrated Health and Social Services Centre (CISSS), the Québec Interprofessional Health Federation (FIQ) and the Sûreté du Québec.

Rapid Lake community

The presentation will be held on Tuesday, October 10, from 10:00 at the community Health Clinic, Rapid Lake.

In collaboration with the La Tuque Native Friendship Centre

Two presentations will be held in collaboration with the La Tuque Native Friendship Centre. The first event will take place on Tuesday, October 10, at 6:00, at the La Tuque Native Friendship Centre, located at 544, Saint-Antoine street. The second will take place on Thursday, October 12, at 6:00, at the Point de services pour les Autochtones at Trois-Rivieres, located 1000 boulevard du Saint-Maurice.

Public organizations

The Commission will offer an information session to representatives of the Abitibi-Témiscamingue Integrated Health and Social Services Centre (CISSS) in Rouyn-Noranda on Wednesday, October 11, and to representatives of the Québec Interprofessional Health Federation (FIQ) and the Sûreté du Québec in Montreal on Friday, October 13.

Meet with the members of the Commission

During these meetings, people will be able to meet with the Commission's employees, ask general questions on how the public hearings will take place, express general concerns about the Commission and share information with the CERP's team. Investigation agents will be available during this time to meet with people in person who wish to share their stories related to one of the six (6) public services included in the mandate of the Commission.
