## **The Quebec Inquiry to visit the Senneterre Native Friendship Centre**

**Val-d'Or, September 7, 2017** – Representatives from the Public Inquiry Commission on relations between Indigenous Peoples and certain public services in Québec: listening, reconciliation and progress will be at the Senneterre Native Friendship Centre, on September 13, to offer a public information session.

### **Senneterre**

The presentation will take place on Wednesday, September 13, from 14:00 at the Senneterre Native Friendship Centre's offices, located at 910, 10<sup>th</sup> avenue in Senneterre. During this meeting, the community members will be able to meet with the Commission's employees, ask general questions on how the public hearings will take place, express general concerns about the Commission and share information with the CERP's team. Investigation agents will be available during this time to meet with people in person who wish to share their stories related to one of the six (6) public services included in the mandate of the Commission.
