

**DECISION CONCERNING THE APPLICATION FOR LIMITED PARTICIPANT
OF
NUNAVIK REGIONAL BOARD OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES**

1. **SEEING** the application of *Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services* for the status of limited participant before the Public Inquiry Commission on relations between Indigenous Peoples and certain public services in Quebec;
2. **CONSIDERING** the application, the declaration under oath of Mr. Jean-François Arteau, attorney, an authorized representative of the applicant and the representations at the hearing of May 11, 2017;
3. **CONSIDERING** that it appears that *Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services* has a direct and genuine interest with respect to the subject of the Commission's inquiry and has an extensive expertise on Inuit territory;
4. **CONSIDERING** that the application is well founded;

WHEREFORE, THE COMMISSIONNER :

5. **GRANTS** the applicant *Nunavik Regional Board of Health and Social Services* the status of a limited participant before the Public Inquiry Commission on relations between Indigenous Peoples and certain public services in Quebec and all rights accorded to a limited participant;
