
# Cree Adult Criminal Justice General Process





## SPECIAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COMMUNITY JUSTICE COMMITTEES

A special agreement is signed between the crown prosecutor and the committees to divert offences. The members represent community values, and are recognized by the local band council.

## DOJCS CORRECTIONS SERVICES DURING THE PROCESS

- Client signs CREE Consent Form Agreement to work with the DOJCS
- Intake Assessment Form to determine risks and needs
- Support references: psychologists, elder and counsellor in detention visits, ministers, spiritual guidance, support letters, treatment applications, community support
- Preliminary, bail and parole hearings support
- Support during prison transfers
- Follow-ups
- Correctional intervention and debriefing
- Professional support services
- Community Reintegration Officer support in reintegration, community programs, and record suspension program

### TYPES OF SENTENCES:

- Fine or victim surcharge
- Suspended sentence
- Conditional or absolute discharge
- Restitution order
- Sentence of imprisonment:
  - → 2 years less a day: provincial prison
  - → 2 years or more: federal penitentiary

Release without conditions

#### **RELEASE**

**Record Suspension** Program — 5 to 10 years waiting period depending on the nature of offence. → Pre-sentence Report

- → Sentencing Hearing
- → Submissions on Sentencing
- → Victim Impact Statement
- → Gladue Report

**Justice Committee** and CJO may be asked to do a Gladue Report


The correctional client process begins once the type of sentence order has been declared.


The correctional team provides support services, and community reintegration services.

The client receives services while in detention, and when released back to the community.

- Conflict resolution services to community members
- Healing or Talking circles
- Reintegration Circles
- Sentencing circles to assist judges in crafting appropriate sentences
- Gladue Reports to ensure judges have all appropriate information about an offender
- Diversion of youth and adult offenders from the courts into healing and treatment
- · Community education in justice and justicerelated matters
- Professional support services
- · Community Justice Officer works with crown, from diverted cases
- Service and support to witnesses and victims during the whole duration of process



#### THE USE OF STATE-OF-THE-ART VIDEO CONFERENCING

- VC can be used for lawyers to conference with their clients before a court date
- VC can be used for the procedure of bail hearing
- VC can be used in trial for witnesses in other communities or locations
- VC can be used to help coordinate interviews to prepare the Gladue Reports, reducing
- VC can also be used for special hearings on keeping drivers' licenses for work
- VC can be used for families to visit offenders while still in detention, reducing hardship
- VC can be used post-detention for mental health sessions with professionals
- VC can be used for special hearings when a client breaches their conditions
- VC can be used in Youth Protection trials
