I asked him : Why did you do that? He answered that he was just kidding!
It brought me back to the past when my boyfriend tried to stab me.
Q 1 : Did you tell the guard about your feelings ?
R 1 : No because I had to go to see the nurse, but I don't think it is a good idea for the guards to do that. They are not supposed to do that.
Q 2 : Do you want to tell your story to the commissioner? Would you want to tell it in person or have me, or a colleague tell your story?
R 2 : I would need someone behind me.
We will call you to inform you if it is necessary or not for you to come and share your story.
