Val-d'Or, May 11, 2017 – The Public Inquiry Commission on relations between Indigenous Peoples and certain public services in Québec: listening, reconciliation and progress has granted this morning a full participant standing to 12 applicants and a limited participant standing to one applicant.

In addition, the President of the Inquiry Jacques Viens has let the audience know during the hearing that many other organizations and associations have expressed their intention to take part to the Inquiry's works by giving testimonies, sharing information and subsequently presenting a written brief.
